"BITS FROM BOB"

"A Budget and A Commitment"

The last few weeks I have heard the same announcements before we have our call to worship. One is a reminder to committee chairmen that their budget proposals need to be received for the next church year soon approaching. The next concerns those officers whose terms are expiring to begin looking for someone to nominate as a replacement for that position.

These are two important decisions a church family needs to consider. They involve a Budget that serves as a guide in using our tithes and offerings for building up the Body of Christ and the Commitment involved in accepting positions of leadership in the Church.

I would like to share a story that paints a picture of what Commitment looks like.

Luciano Pavarotti said that when he was a boy, his father, a baker, introduced him to the wonders of song. He encouraged him to work hard to develop his voice. Arrigo Pola, a professional tenor in his hometown of Modena, Italy, took him as a pupil. Pavarotti also enrolled in a teachers college. On graduating, he asked his father, "Shall I be a teacher or a singer?" "Luciano, his father replied, "If you try to sit on two chairs, you will fall between them. For life, you must choose one chair." Pavarotti, later in life wrote: "I choose one. It took seven years of study and frustration before I made my first professional appearance. It took another seven to reach the Metropolitan Opera. And now I think whether it's laying bricks, writing books, whatever we choose we should give ourselves to it. Commitment-that's the key. Choose one chair."

In Luke 6:38 is recorded these words by Jesus:

"Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap."

Many times, this scripture is used to encourage us in the giving of our tithes and offerings. This is clearly misinterpreting the words of Jesus. When you read the entire chapter, Jesus speaks of "seeking after righteousness," "loving your enemies," showing "mercy," and not being "judgmental."

Jesus is telling us that our attitudes and the way we treat others will also be measured to each of us.

I am honored to be your pastor and I pray that each of us will prayerfully consider what God wants us to give for his work. Not just our tithes and offerings but also our time and talents. "For the measure you will give will be the measure you get back."

Highlights from the Board Meeting held on April 4, 2024

Chairman Tammy Mayo called the bi-monthly board meeting to order and opened with prayer. A silent roll was taken with ten members present.

Mary Alice Noel presented the Treasurer's Report. The Church began with a balance of \$210,909.55 on January 1st. Total receipts were \$17.656.05, total disbursements were \$15,727.16, money in the amount of \$50,000 was moved from the general fund to a CD making 4.5% interest for 13 months and \$3,560.91 is in the Givelify account which gives a balance in Regular Checking of \$166,399.35 as of February 29, 2024. As for our Designated Funds, we have \$505 in the Food Pantry, \$180 for Bible Study, \$450 for the Cemetery, \$500 for the Building Fund, \$2,275 in the Samaritan Fund, \$260 for Worship, \$459 for Youth and \$550 for Missions which is a total of \$5,179. The Savings Account has \$13,318.36. There was discussion about closing this savings account and placing the money in a CD. Mary Alice will transfer the money. The Church has three CDs that total \$151,473.73. Report was accepted.

Jane Harris presented the Cemetery Treasurer's Report dated January 17th through March 18th, 2024. The current Principal Amount in a CD (not to be used for upkeep) is \$26,935 with \$700 being held to place in a CD. The current amount in General Checking (to be used for general maintenance for the cemetery) is \$11,847.76. Report was accepted.

Tammy approached a couple to take over the Youth Group and will follow up with them on their decision. At least two District 10 youths are planning on attending camp this summer.

Dana Crawford, Missions Chairman reported two Easter offerings were collected that totaled \$400. A love offering is being collected for the Proffitts.

Jeff Clough, Property Chairman confirmed Firefly has been installed and is working great. The monthly service fee is \$84 a month since HGCC is classified as a business. Jeff stated the church currently has one laptop that is used for the sanctuary displays and we need another computer in order to stream our Sunday service. Jeff has been using his personal computer for streaming. To purchase a desktop computer would be \$840. Motion was carried to buy. Jeff priced new play sets; one at \$3,700 and one at \$6,800 (both are wooden). It was decided to move forward with this project with a cost up to \$5,000.

Bob shared that he thought the Easter service was nice. The CW&W story added a lot to the service.

The Christian Education Chair and Christian Youth Fellowship leader still need to be filled.

Constitution changes still need to be considered and are on Tammy's to-do list.

The Church pamphlet still needs to be updated and Steve Montgomery will follow up on this with Pastor Andy Rose.

Once the storage room construction is completed, Tammy will change the door passcode.

Mulch for the playground is here and stacked outside. We will wait for installation of the new playground and then schedule spreading of the mulch.



Jeff confirmed that the communion portion of the worship service is not streamed.

Pew cushions were brought up again. After more discussion, it was determined we will not be purchasing them.

Steve noticed during the Easter Service, that many caps/tips are missing from the legs of our metal chairs and were getting dirt in them. He will look into finding new caps.

Tammy adjourned the meeting.
